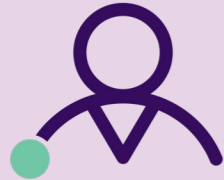
Recurring Transport

- Home and garden maintenance
- Showering and dressing support
- Support Workers



2. Transport

- Transport funding can help you access taxis or rides for therapy appointments



3. Consumables

- Continence products
- Sensory items
- Modified cutlery
- Low cost, low risk assistive technology



4. Assistance with Social, Economic & Community Participation

- Support worker to attend event or activities with you
- Attending day programs or group activities

- Wheelchairs
- Prosthetics
- Braille related resources
- Vehicle Modifications including, hand controls, wheelchair lifts and ramps, seat modifications



6. Home Modifications

- Shower rails
- Wheelchair ramps
- A project manager to oversee the modifications



17. Specialised Disability Accommodation (SDA)

- This funds specialist housing that assists people who have high physical support needs and funds the homes services are delivered in.

- Repairs and Maintenance of Assistive Technology

7. Support Coordinators & Psychosocial Recovery Coaches

8. Improved Living Arrangements

- Financial counselling
- Support workers to attend house inspections with you
- Help negotiating contracts

- Life Skills Coaching
- Sports Coaching
- Mentor to help build independence

10. Finding & Keeping a Job

- Resume writing support
- Support at job interviews
- Support moving from school to work

11. Relationships

- Support to develop skills for participation in community and social activities

12. Health & Wellbeing

- Dietician
- Personal Trainer
- Exercise Physiologist

13. Life Long Learning

- Advice on further education
- Support with applications to further education organisations
- Support at orientation events

14. Choice & Control

- This budget can be used to fund a plan manager, like NDSP, to help manage your funding and pay providers.

- Occupational Therapy
